DATA SOURCES
Most data were obtained from the Environmental GIS Data distributed by the Connecticut DEP. Roads, lakes, and streams are based on USGS DLG files. Road data were enhanced through the use of GPS, digital orthophotos, and town review. The Appalachian Trail was obtained through the use of a GPS receiver with 2-5 meter positional accuracy. Town parcels data were updated by the Housatonic Valley Association with information provided by the Kent Tax Assessor.

Town Character Areas represent cultural and scenic areas of great significance for the town character and open space purposes.
